Squadbuilder Grants 2020

2020 has been such a difficult time for rugby league during the Covid 19 pandemic. We at Squadbuilder acknowledge the hard work of the Warrington Wolves Community Coaching team in supporting the Community clubs return to play programme. A lot of planning has gone into ensuring this happens safely under the strict RFL, Government and Council guidelines for the players, coaches, parents, officials and volunteers.

It is part of our remit to support the development, coaching and promotion of young rugby players at all levels. We are delighted to be able to support the Community Clubs at this really difficult time. Squadbuilder are inviting applications from the Community Clubs in Warrington for a grant of **up to £500 per club**.

What can you claim?

Squadbuilder is offering grants of up to £500 to the Youth and Junior sections of each Community Club in Warrington. **One application per club**.

What can this payment be used for?

The bid can be for equipment, e.g. balls, tackle bags, or for kit or a tangible asset to benefit the club. It may also be used to purchase items to help clubs comply with Covid 19 guidelines. e.g., signage, PPE, hand sanitiser and wipes. You must justify the bid and give evidence of the budget. The budget cannot be retrospective, it must be used for proposed purchases. Applications to be made by a designated official of the club

Timescale

The deadline for applications will be **30th November**. The award of grants will be announced on **Friday 11th December 2020**

Conditions

The Community clubs must agree to spend the grant as per bid by 31st March 2021
Each club to show acknowledgement to Squadbuilder of the grant on the amateur club social media and website.

The clubs must inform all their members of the grant award.

The clubs will be asked to signpost their members to join Squadbuilder and support the development of Youth rugby league development in the town.

They must use social media to visually demonstrate the items purchased on at least 4 occasions.
